

RoHS and RoHS3 Compliance

To Whom It May Concern:

On January 27, 2003, the European Union established directives known as WEEE (Waste from Electrical & Electronic Equipment) & RoHS (Restriction of certain Hazardous Substances). These directives will affect all electronic products that will be imported into the EU and went into full effect July 1, 2006.

The RoHS and subsequent RoHS3 (2001/65/EU) (EU2015/863) additions of the directive bans the sale of electrical & electronic products produced using specific materials: Lead, Mercury, Chromium, Cadmium and certain Brominated flame retardants. This includes select Phthalates. Only Compliant materials can be sold as of July 1, 2006.

Star continues to be responsive in this area; the formulations of our products are intended to be in compliance with **RoHS and RoHS3** directives concerning banned substances. We do not add any items that are on the banned substances list.
